

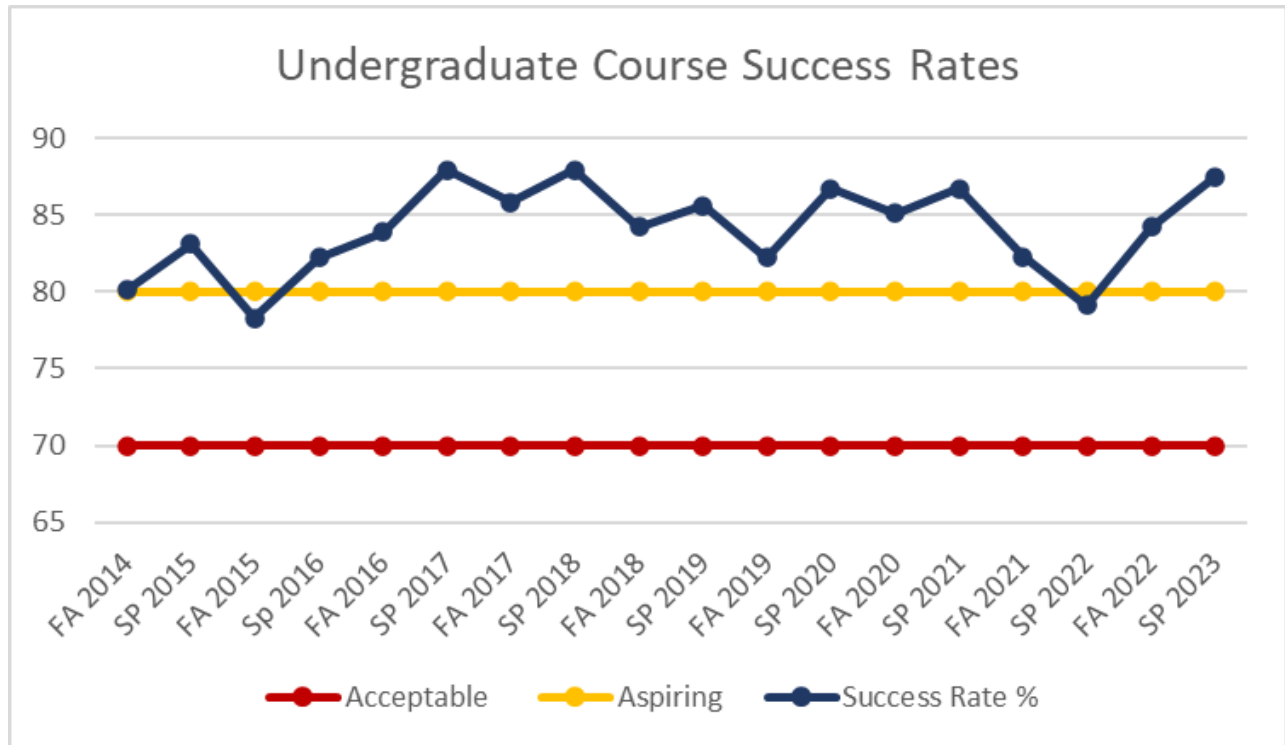

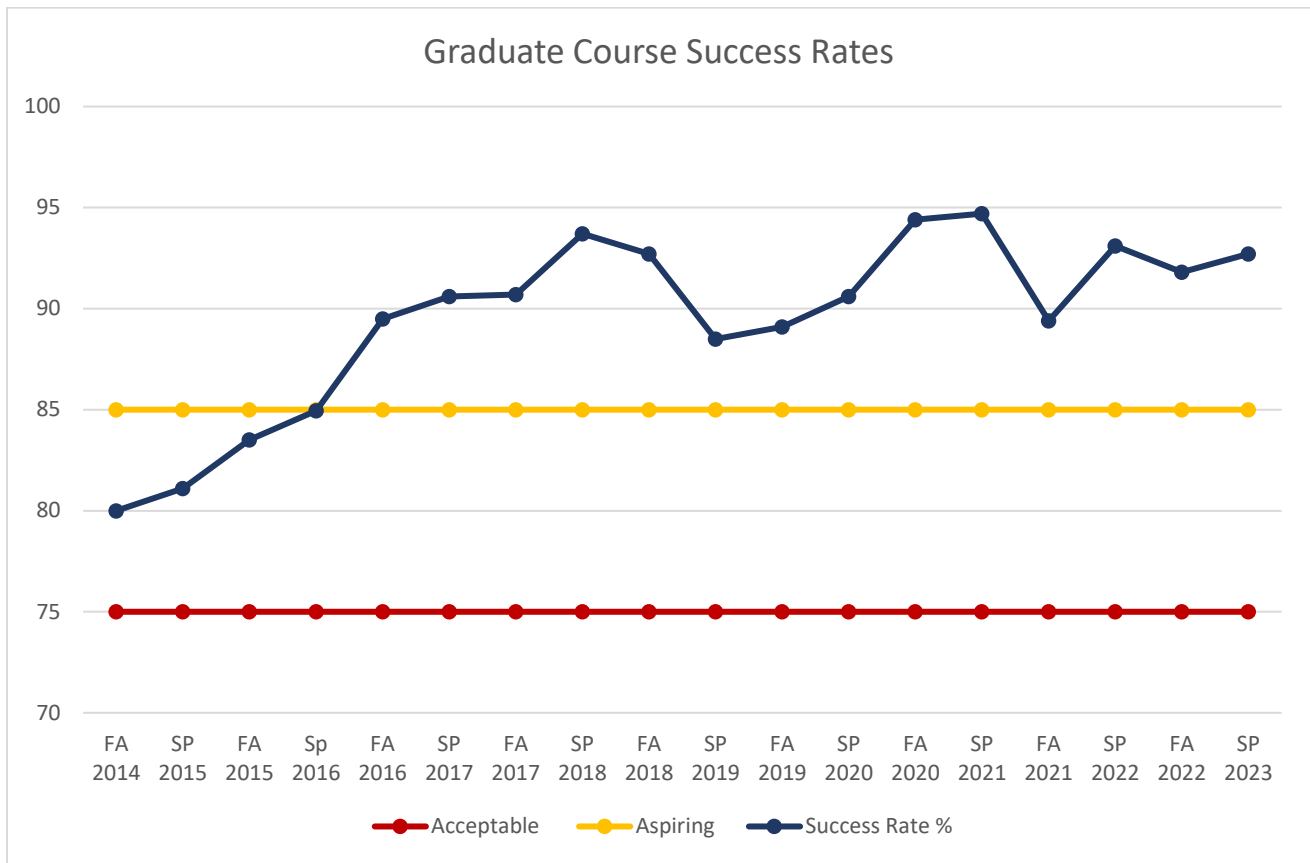
**Undergraduate Course Success Rates:** Acceptable level: 70% / Aspiring Level: 80%

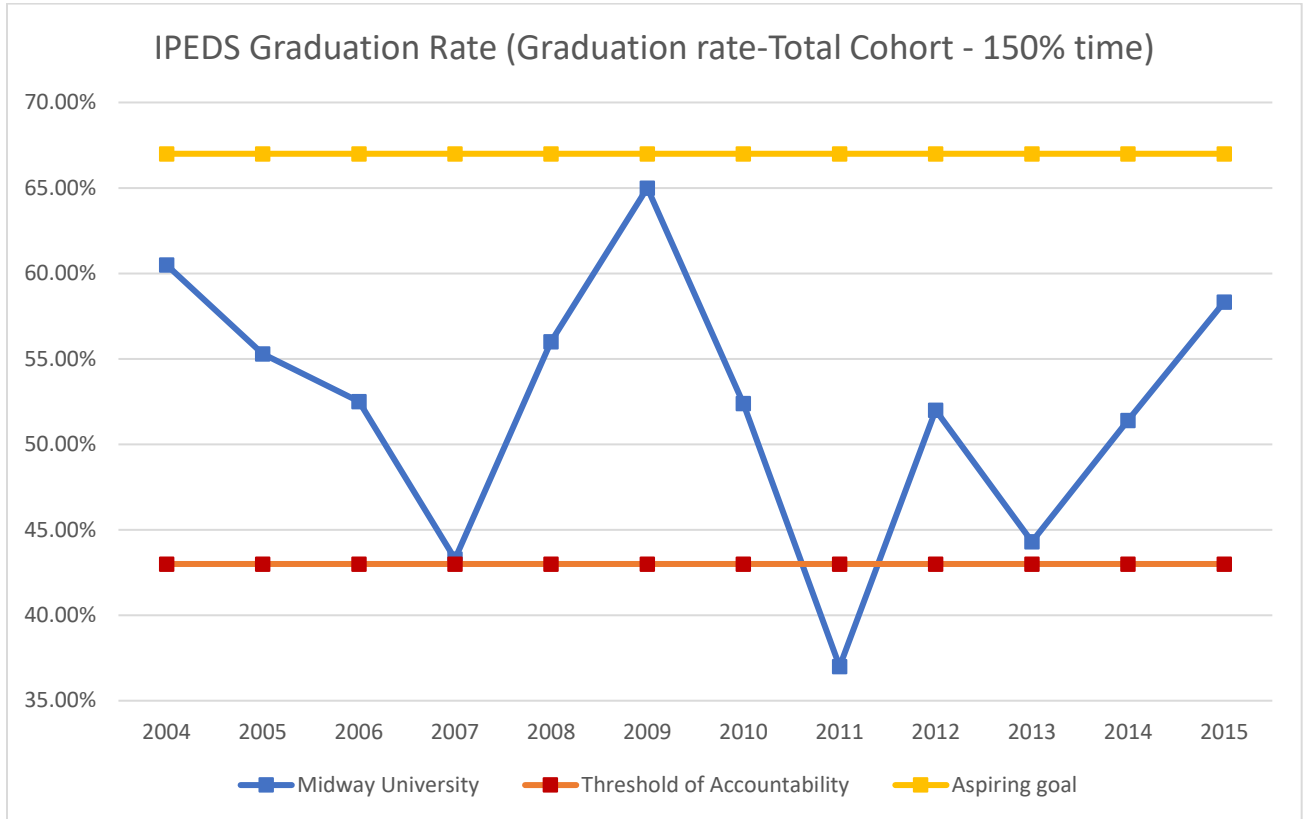

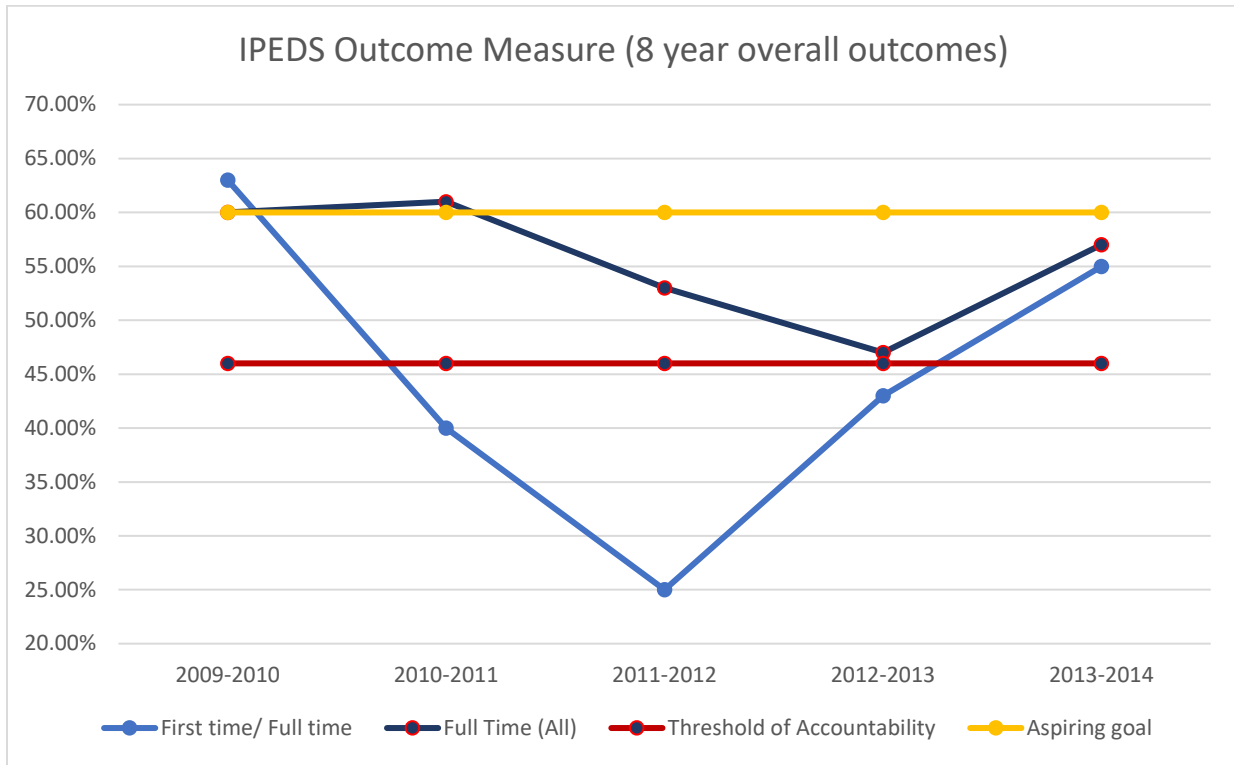

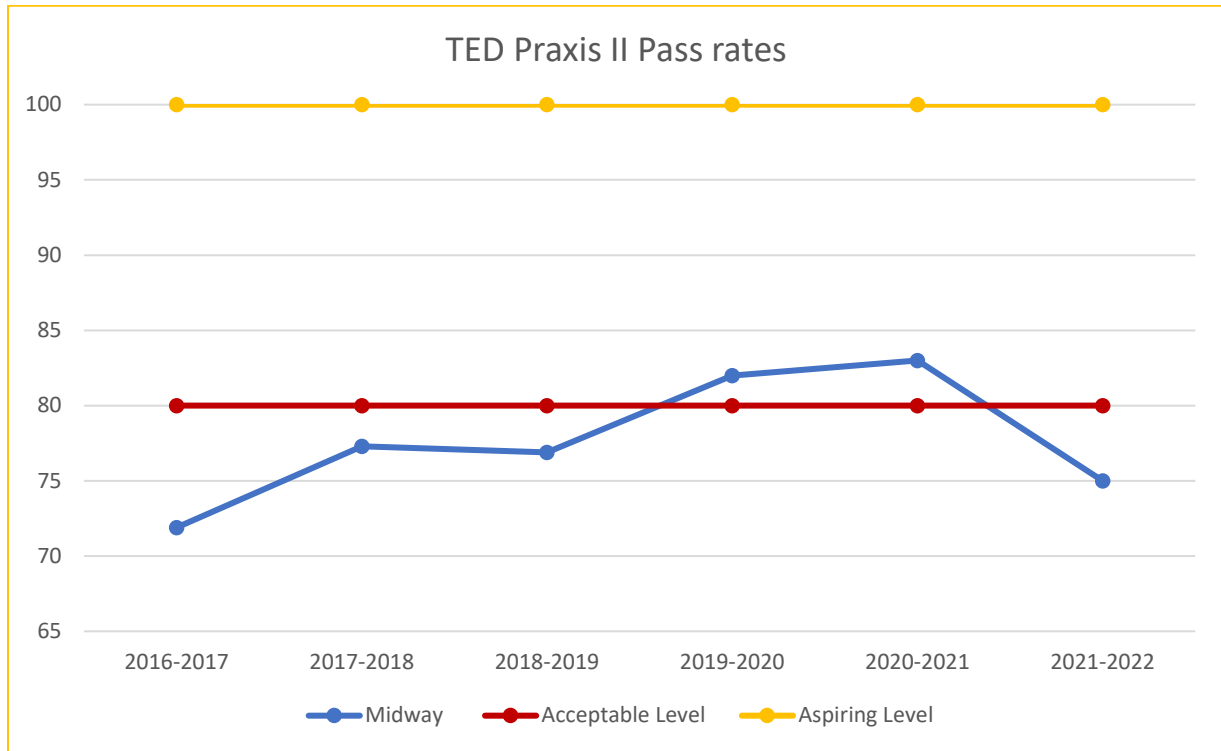

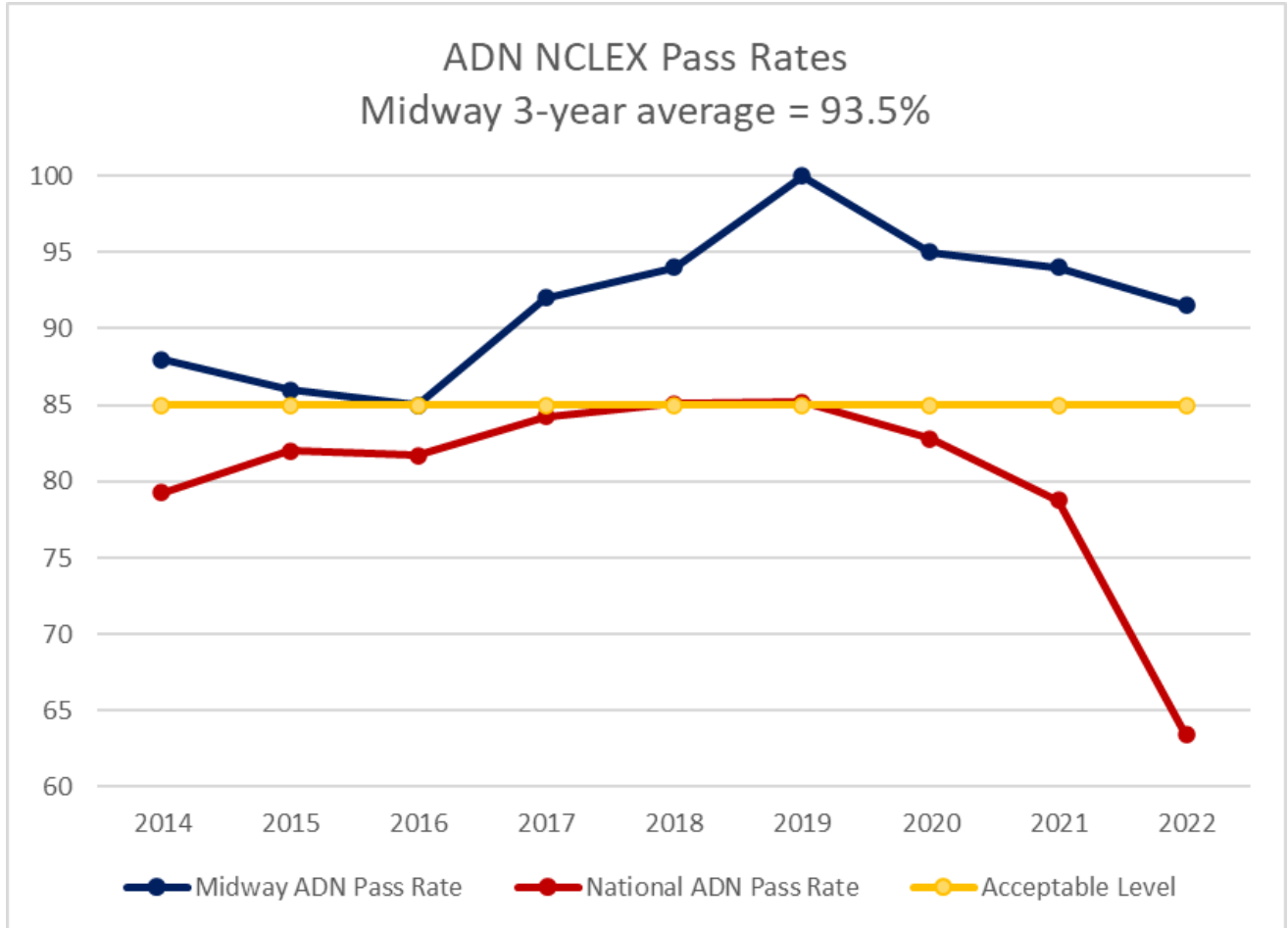

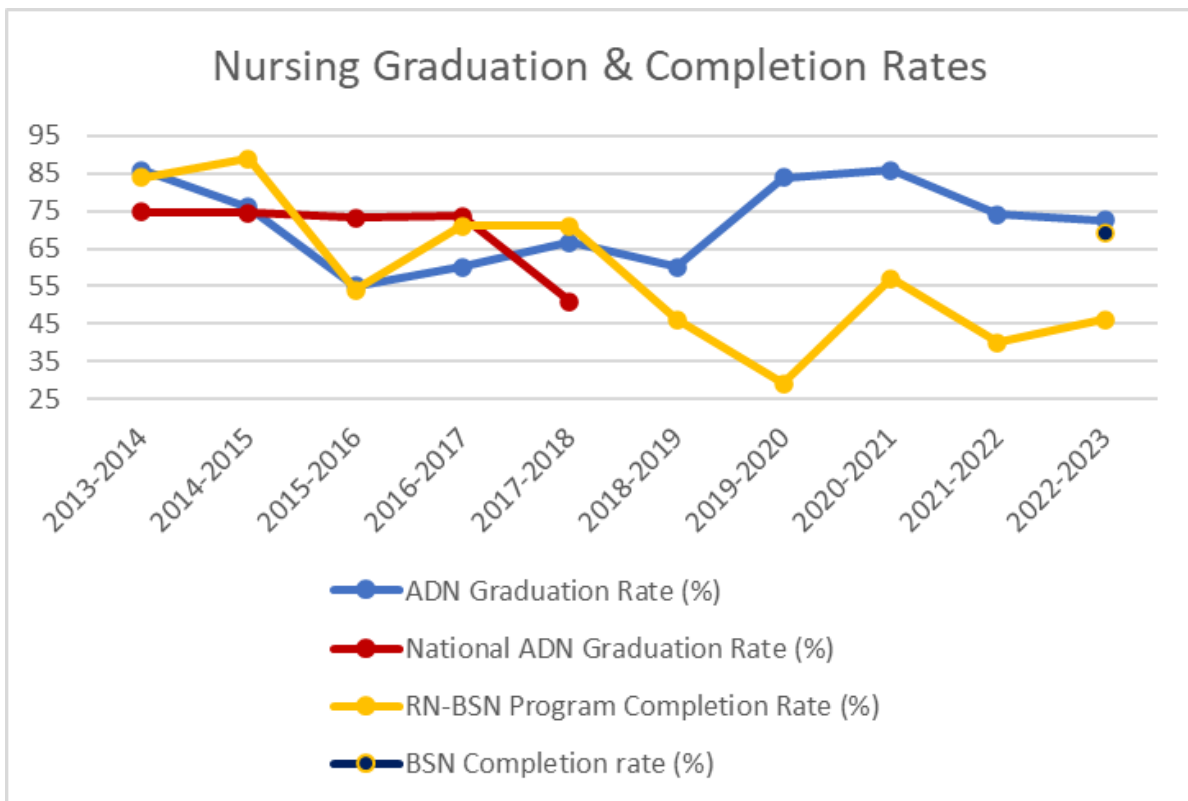
